Dates:	Saturday, December 19, 2009 <u>Small-bore Rifle ONLY</u> Sunday December 20, 2009 <u>Air Rifle ONLY</u>
Location:	Reading Rifle and Revolver Club, Haverhill St., Reading MA
Eligibility:	This competition is open to all US Citizens born in 1988 or later. Competitors must also be a current member of USA Shooting.
Residence:	Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residences are eligible for the 1 st , 2 nd , and 3 rd place USA Shooting State Champion Medallions. Non-Residents may compete for automatic and at-large invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so.
State Resident Qualifiers:	USA Shooting will issue official invitations to the National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships (NJOSC) for the high scoring male and high scoring female residence from each state JOSC, provided they fire a minimum qualifying score. Resident collegiate and /or military competitors are eligible for the state residence awards and are also eligible for resident state qualifier invitations.
Entry:	Shooters MAY NOT compete in more than one state JORC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JORC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JORC and those who cannot attend their own state JORC will be allowed to enter the automatic/at-large division in another state. At entry, non-resident juniors must declare that they are shooting for an at-large/automatic invitation. Residents may choose to enter the Automatic/ At-large category instead of the Resident Qualifier category if they are confident they can shoot above the automatic score and secure an invitation. This would allow another competitor

	<p>to receive the State Qualifier invitation.</p> <p>A. RESIDENT QUALIFIER – Competitors shooting in their declared state of permanent residency. Competitors in this category are eligible to be the state resident qualifier to the National JOSOC.</p> <p>B. AUTOMATIC/AT-LARGE – Competitors shooting in other than their declared state of residency are eligible for at-large/automatic invitations to the National JOSOC.</p> <p>C. Applications must be submitted by Friday December 11th with payment to hold your relay spot.</p>
Teams:	<p>Teams will consist of 4 Firing Members</p> <p>Teams must be submitted before the start of each match.</p>
**Shoot Off	<p>The top 8 shooters each day only, will compete for a separate award (to be determined). The Shoot off will occur approx 20 minutes after the finalization of scores.</p> <p>The shoot off will comprise of 10 shots, fired one at a time. After each shot a pre-selected scoring team will go down range and determine and call out the value of each shot value until all 10 shots have been fired. Challenges are not allowed.</p> <p>*Note Shoot-off Participants will be chosen from the first 4 targets shot for men and women in air rifle</p>
Categories:	<p>The following categories will be used for the individual and team competition based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2010</p> <p>J1 – Junior – age 18 to 21 – 1990, 1991, 1992</p> <p>J2 – Int Jr - age 15 to 17 – 1993, 1994, 1995</p> <p>J3 - Sub Jr – age 14 and under, born 1996 or later.</p>
Rules:	<p>Current USA Shooting Rules will govern the competition.</p>
Course of Fire:	<p>Small-bore (Men and Women): 60 shots (20 prone, 20 standing, 20 kneeling) Air Rifle (Men) 60 shots, 105 minutes offhand (Women) 40 shots, 75 minutes offhand</p>
Time limits:	<p>Small-bore: 20 shots prone: 40 minutes 20 shots standing: 60 minutes 20 shots kneeling: 50 minutes Air rifle: Men – 60 shots, 105 minutes Women – 40 shots, 75 minutes</p>
Rifle:	<p>Small-bore: Any .22 cal. Rifle meeting USAS rules 4.2 and 4.3 Air Rifle: Any .177 cal. Air rifle (co2 or compressed air), rule 4.6</p>
Sights:	<p>Metallic sights only; Rule 4.2.5</p>
Targets:	<p>Small-bore – USA Shooting 50' indoor target (10 record bulls) Air Rifle - AR 5/10 (10 record bulls)</p>

Distance:	Small-bore – Fifty (50) feet Air Rifle – Ten (10) meters (approx. 33 feet)
Coaching:	Coaching will not be permitted.
Protests:	A scoring protest of \$1.00 will be charged, if the protest is won the \$1.00 will be returned to the challenger. If the challenge is lost, the \$1.00 is not returned.
Ties:	All ties will be broken according to USA Shooting rules.
Participation Pins:	A Junior Olympic Participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.
Awards:	<p>USA Shooting will provide a Gold, Silver and Bronze medallion to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place resident individual in both small-bore and air rifle.</p> <p>Woburn Sportsmen will present medals to the high scoring junior, intermediate junior and sub junior in both small-bore and air rifle for both men and women. The champions small-bore and air rifle champion will also have his or her name added to the rotating trophies and will receive championship plaques. A plaque will also be presented to the high scoring teams in small-bore and air-rifle provided that there are three or more teams entered into each discipline</p> <p>Shoot-off winner prize to be determined</p> <p>NOTE: All awards will be presented at the completion of the shoot off.</p>

Range Capacity:	The capacity of each relay is thirteen (13) competitors

Directions:	From Boston-- Take I-93N to Exit 37A. Merge onto I-95 N towards Peabody. Take I-95 exit 40 towards Wakefield Ctr/North Reading. Coming off of the ramp, go around the rotary and go back under 128, staying in the right lane. Haverhill St. is the first street on the right (National Guard Base on your right). Continue on Haverhill for approx. one mile. On your right will be a sign for Burlington Ice Arena and Reading Rifle & Revolver.
